Aloha 'oukou! The Annual Keiki Heihei Wa'a (youth regatta) will consist of a long distance course and sprint course. The long distance course will be a 4.5 mile distance and the sprint (regatta) course will be a 500m straightaway. The straightaway course will have 4-6 lanes and begins and ends in front of the crowd on the beach. There will be two race turns for 17 and older teams.

Along with our Keiki Heihei Wa'a, we will also be hosting our annual **Stand Up for the Kids SUP Race** for youths and adults on the same day! The stand- up paddle race on Saturday will be a 1-mile race for nā 'opio under 17 years old and a 4.5 mile course for everyone else. Keiki's can participate in both paddling events.

Canoes from a pool of similarly-rigged Bradley's will be assigned randomly to crews throughout the day. Please respect the canoes you are borrowing. We ask that everyone step up to help unload, rig, un-rig and re-load the canoes. Mahalo nui loa in advance for your cooperation and kōkua.

Divisions: All Keiki (includes Boys and Girls) Age division races will consist of several heats. Coed teams are allowed to race in the Boys division. There will also be "Mixed Plate-Teams" that will consist of Coed teams assembled from different clubs on race day. All Keiki races will be on a measured 500m course. An adult steersmen will be allowed to steer but not paddle in
